

Ordinance No.25

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING SAFETY REGULATIONS FOR PRESENT DEPOSITORS OR STORERS OF INDUSTRIAL WASTES, WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON, WEST MORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

The Township of South Huntingdon hereby ordains and enacts:

1. That every present Depositors or storers of industrial wastes, either liquid or solids, within the Township of South Huntingdon, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, shall fence such property with an Eight (8) foot chain fence to be equipped with a locking system so as to be firmly locked when unattended.

2. That said fence shall be erected within three (3) months from the effective date of this Ordinance.

3. Any person or firm or Corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, before any Justice of the Peace, be sentenced to pay a fine of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, PROVIDED, each day's continuance of a violation of any of the provisions of this ORDINANCE shall constitute a separate offense.
