

ORDINANCE NO.26

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS AND LICENSE FEE FOR STORERS OR DEPOSITORS OF INDUSTRIAL WASTES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

The Township of South Huntingdon hereby ordains and enacts:

1. The term "industrial wastes" shall mean damaged, defective or superfluous material produced during or left over from a manufacturing process or industrial operation, and shall include material not usable for ordinary or main purpose of manufacturing, and shall be either liquid or solid form.
2. Every storer or depositors of such industrial wastes within the Township of South Huntingdon, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, shall obtain a license from the Township Secretary, which license or permit shall be in the sum of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (\$250.00) DOLLARS, ANNUALLY, and such payment shall be made before commencement of operations.
3. Every storer or depositors of such industrial wastes, shall locate their operations not nearer than six hundred (600) yards from the nearest public road or roads.
4. Every storer or depositors of such industrial wastes shall erect a chain fence around their operations, as prescribed in Ordinance No. 25 of South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania.
5. Every storer or depositors of industrial wastes, as aforesaid, shall permit no noxious odors, dust, or gas, from their operations.
6. Any person or firm or Corporation, who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace, be sentenced to pay a fine of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS and costs of prosecution, PROVIDED, each day's continuance of a violation of any of the provisions of this ORDINANCE, shall constitute a separate offense.
