

ORDINANCE n0.29

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENN - SYLVANIA, PROVIDING THAT PARKED VEHICLES, UNINSPECTED AND UNLICENSED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE PUBLIC ROADS, STREETS, OR ALLEYS IN SAID TOWNSHIP, INCLUDING THE TOWNSHIP RIGHTS OF WAY IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, WITHIN 48 HOURS FROM THE PARKING OF SUCH VEHICLE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES.

THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON HEREBY ORDAINS AND ENACTS:

SECTION 1. That from the effective date of this Ordinance, all parked vehicles, uninspected and unlicensed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, shall be removed from the public roads, streets, or ~~alleys~~ in said Township of South Huntingdon, including Township rights of way in connection therewith, within 48 hours from the parking of such vehicle.

SECTION 2. Any person, or firm, or Corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof before any Alderman or Justice of the Peace, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, provided, each day's continuance of a violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall constitute a separate offense.
