

ORDINANCE #3.

FIXING WEIGHT LIMITATIONS FOR VEHICLES USING THAT PORTION OF THE TOWNSHIP ROAD SYSTEM OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BEGINNING AT A POINT AT THE INTERSECTION OF TOWNSHIP ROADS 313 and 317; THENCE ALONG TOWNSHIP ROAD 317 TO THE POINT OF INTERSECTION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD 317 and 386; THENCE ALONG TOWNSHIP ROAD 386 TO POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH L.R. 64122; AND BRIDGES TRAVERSED THEREON.

THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the permissible weights of vehicles using a portion of the Township road system BEGINNING at a point at the intersection of Township Roads 313 and 317; thence along Township road 317 to point of intersection of Township Road 317 and 386; thence along Township road 386 to point of intersection with L.R. 64122; be fixed at a gross maximum weight of 20,000 lbs.

2. That the permissible weights of vehicles using and traversing Township bridges on that portion of the Township road system, BEGINNING at a point at the intersection of Township Roads 313 and 317; thence along Township Road 317 to the point of intersection of Township road 317 and 386; thence along Township road 386 to point of intersection with L.R. 64122, be fixed at a gross maximum weight of 20,000 lbs.

THIS ORDINANCE enacted under the authority of the Act of 1929 May 1, P.L. 905, Art. XI, Sections 1101 and 1102, and amendments and supplements thereto, the said Township Supervisors having determined that said portion of the Township road system and Township bridges thereon are in a state of deterioration, and will be seriously damaged or destroyed, unless the permissible weights of vehicles using said portion of the Township road system and bridges thereon is reduced.
