

ORDINANCE No. 33

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 2051 OF THE SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE, AND PRESCRIBING DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, deems it necessary to create a Township Planning Commission for the purpose of encouraging the orderly and efficient development of the Township, and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Township Supervisors of South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, viz:

Section 1. The Township Supervisors hereby create by Ordinance a Planning Commission consisting of five persons:

- 1. ALDO ZULIAN, Yukon, Pa. Appointment for one year from date.
- 2. MAX SAPINSKY, Box 183, Smithton, Pa. R.D. Appointment for two years from date.
- 3. CHARLES BOBICH, Jacobs Creek, Pa. Appointment for three years from date.
- 4. ROBERT MOMYER, R.D. #1, Smithton, Pa. Appointment for four years from date.
- 5. THOMAS KIRSHNER, West Newton, Pa. Appointment for five years from date.

Annually thereafter a member of the Commission shall be appointed for a term of five years. An appointment to fill a vacancy shall be for the unexpired portion of the term. All members of the Commission shall reside within the Township.

Section 2. The Planning Commission shall render such reports, assume such responsibility, authority and duties as are detailed under Section 2051 of the Second Class Township Code.

Section 3. If such sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentence, clauses or sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Township Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof had not been included herein.

Section 4. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance, is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
