

ORDINANCE NO.35

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE COMMISSION OF THE ELECTED TAX COLLECTOR OF TOWNSHIP TAXES FOR SOUTH HUNTINGDON TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FROM THE SUM OF FIVE (5%) PERCENTUM, TO THE SUM OF FOUR (4%) PERCENTUM OF THE NET TOWNSHIP TAXES COLLECTED.

THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Commission of the elected tax collector of Township taxes for South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, be reduced from the sum of FIVE (5%) percentum to the sum of FOUR (4%) Percentum of the net Township Taxes collected.

2. This Ordinance is made under the authority of Sec.36.1,72 P.S.5511.36a as amended, of the Local Tax Collection Law of May 25, 1945, P.L.1050.

3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
