

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF MOTOR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON TOWNSHIP ROADS AND ALSO PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Supervisors of South Huntingdon Township that certain motor vehicles have been using Township roads in violation of posted weight limits or other lawful restrictions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, and it is hereby ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the authority of the same that:

(1) The word "person" as used in this Ordinance shall mean any natural person, partnership, association, firm or corporation.

(2) No person shall drive any motor vehicle, or cause such motor vehicle to be driven, over Township roads in violation of weight limits, or other lawful restrictions, posted by the Supervisors of South Huntingdon Township.

(3) Any person convicted before a Justice of the Peace or Magistrate of violating this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine or penalty of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs for each such offense or undergo imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days for non-payment of such fine or penalty and costs within ten (10) days from the imposition thereof.

(4). Any Ordinances or Resolutions or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they affect this Ordinance.
