An ordinance of the Township of South Huntingdon, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, fiscal year 1975.

The Township of South Huntingdon hereby ordians the Following:

A tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the Township of South Huntingdon, subject to taxation for Township purposes for the year 1975.

1. Tax rate for general Township purposes, the sum of 10 mills on each dollar of Assessed Valuation.

2. The following taxes have been re-enacted for the year 1975 without substantial change:

(a) One (1%) ^{100 per cent} per cent real estate transfer tax.

(b) Ten(\$10.00) Dollar occupational privilege tax.

(c) Ten(\$10.00) Dollar flat rate occupation tax.

TOTAL MILLAGE: 10 mills.
