

The following ordinance will be presented for final enactment at a regular meeting of the South Huntingdon Township Supervisors to be held at the Township Building, West Newton, Pennsylvania, R.D. #1 on Tuesday December 14, 1976, at 3:00 P.M.

An ordinance of the Township of South Huntingdon, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, fiscal year 1977.

The Township of South Huntingdon hereby ordians the following:

A tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the Township of South Huntingdon, subject to taxation for Township purposes for the year 1977.

1. Tax rate for general Township purposes, the sum of 10 mills on each dollar of Assessed Valuation.
2. The following taxes have been re-enacted for the year 1977 without substantial change:
 - (a). One (1%) per cent real estate transfer tax.
 - (b). Ten (\$10.00) Dollar occupational privilege tax.
 - (c). Ten (\$10.00) Dollar flat rate occupational tax.

TOTAL MILLAGE: 10 mills.
