

ORDINANCE #6

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A ROAD IN SOUTH HUNTINGDON TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA IN PLAN OF LOTS, AS RECORDED IN AND FOR SAID COUNTY AND COMMONWEALTH IN PLAN BOOK VOLUME 13, PAGE 233; BEGINNING AT A POINT IN U.S. HIGHWAY ROUTE NO. 31, LEADING FROM WEST NEWTON TO MOUNT PLEASANT AS SHOWN ON SAID PLAN: THENCE ALONG A THIRTY-THREE (33) FOOT ROAD, NORTH $15^{\circ}28'$ East, 816 FEET MORE OR LESS, TO A POINT, THE PLACE OF ENDING, TO BE A PUBLIC ROAD.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, that from and after the passage of this Ordinance that a road in Plan of lots as recorded in the Recorder of Deeds Office in and for Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and situate in South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and being more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at a point in U.S. Highway Route No. 31, leading from West Newton to Mount Pleasant as shown on said plan; thence along a thirty-three (33) foot road, North $15^{\circ}28'$ East 816 feet more or less to a point, the place of ending, be and the same is hereby declared to be a public road in said Township and part of the Township road system.

A map showing the location of the proposed road is on file with the Township Secretary, Mike Ritz, Jacobs Creek, Penna.
