

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF TAX CERTIFICATIONS BY THE DULY ELECTED TAX COLLECTOR, SETTING THE COSTS AND FEES FOR THE SAME AND ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF THE TAX COLLECTOR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of South Huntingdon, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION I: From and after January 1, 1990, the duly elected Tax Collector of the Township of South Huntingdon shall provide upon request, a written statement, certified by him or her, of the taxes and or assessments collectible by the Tax Collector which remain due and owing for each taxable or property in the Township.

SECTION II: The fee for such tax certification shall be the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars, which fee shall be paid to the tax collector at the time of the request.

SECTION III: The Tax Collector shall remit to the Treasurer of the Township, on or before the tenth day of each and every month, all sums collected by him or her for the preceding calendar month for such tax certifications, along with a statement indentifying the name of the requesting party, the property or taxable involved, the date of the request and certification and the sum charged and collected.

SECTION IV: The Tax Collector shall be compensated on a monthly basis for the issuance of such tax certifications in an amount equal to the amount collected by the Tax Collector and remitted to the Township Treasurer for such tax certifications. Said compensation shall be paid to the Tax Collector on or before the 20th day of the month for the preceding calendar month.

SECTION V: The compensation paid to the Tax Collector for such certifications shall be in addition to the other compensation due and payable to the Tax Collector for the collection of Township Taxes and Assessments.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1990.
