

ORDINANCE #9.

AN ORDINANCE, AMENDING SECTION 2 OF AN ORDINANCE DATED 4th MAY, 1959 REGULATING AND REQUIRING THE LICENSING OF JUNK DEALERS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON hereby ordains as follows:

That Section 2 of an ORDINANCE dated 4th May 1959, regulating and requiring the licensing of junk dealers in the Township of South Huntingdon, and prescribing penalties for violation, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. No person shall engage in business as a junk dealer in the Township of South Huntingdon, without first having obtained a license from the Supervisors of South Huntingdon Township, for which license the fee shall be Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, for each and every calendar year, such fee to be for the use of the Township. Such license shall be renewed annually on or before the first day of January of each year. PROVIDED: In any case where a junk dealer's business shall be established in the Township on or after the first day of July in any year, the license fee payable by such junk dealer for the remainder of such year shall be at one-half the yearly rate.
