ORDINANCE NO. 100

SOUTH HUNTINDON TOWNSHIP WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING SOUTH HUNTINGDON TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 100 AND ESTABLISHING STATUTORY 25 MJLES PER HOUR SPEED LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON CERTAIN ROADWAYS WITHIN SOUTH HUNTINGDON TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, Act 1998-151, Act of December 21, 1998, P.L. 1126, No. 151, found at 75 Pa.C.S. §3362(a)(1.2) and §3363, authorizes Pennsylvania municipalities, subject to 75 Pa.C.S. § 6109(e), to set the speed limit at twenty-five (25) miles per hour on certain locally-owned roads without a prior engineering and traffic study; and

WHEREAS, certain roads exist within South Huntingdon Township, a Pennsylvania second class township (the "Township"), where no speed limits have been established or where conditions warrant a reduction of the speed limits previously adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of South Huntingdon Township deems it to be in the best interests, and for the general welfare of the citizens and residents of the Township to enact twenty-five (25) miles per hour speed limits on certain roads in the Township pursuant to Act 1998-151;

WHEREAS, the within Ordinance is intended to create South Huntingdon Township Ordinance Number 100 by establishing 25 MPH speed limits on certain Township roads.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, to wit:

SECTION I: Title. This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "South Huntingdon Township Statutory 25 MPH Speed Limit Ordinance Amendment."

<u>SECTION 2: Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Roads.</u> The following speed limits are hereby established:

	<u>Location</u>	Speed Limit
Waltz Drive West	entire length	25
tate Hill Road	entire length	95

<u>SECTION 3: Enforcement.</u> This Ordinance shall be enforced by any authorized police officer in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania as it pertains to fines and other penalties.

<u>SECTION 4:</u> <u>Severability</u>. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of the provisions hereof shall be found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

SECTION 5. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions conflicting or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed but only insofar as same are in direct. conflict or directly inconsistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of its enactment.
