

ORDINANCE No.15

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING DISORDERLY CONDUCT WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Township of South Huntingdon hereby ordains as follows:

Disorderly conduct is hereby prohibited within the Township of South Huntingdon. Any person who shall be guilty of any act, word, or conduct causing or tending to cause a disturbance of the peace and good order of the Township or causing or tending to cause any danger, discomfort or annoyance to any of the inhabitants of the Township or users of the roads, thoroughfares, or who shall wilfully make any loud, boisterous or unseemly noise or disturbance, or who shall fight or quarrel or incite others to fight or quarrel, or who shall publicly make use of obscene or indecent language or who shall loaf or loiter or congregate upon any of the public streets or alleys or public grounds in the Township of South Huntingdon, to the annoyance of peaceable residents nearby, or traveling upon any street or alley or being lawfully upon any of the public grounds in the Township, or who shall attract children and other persons by means of bells, chimes or other noise making devices, in the sale or vending of ice cream, candies or other products whether by use of such devices on a vehicle or on foot, or who shall block public streets and highways by such sales, whereby the public peace is broken and disturbed and the traveling public annoyed, shall be guilty of disorderly conduct. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ORDINANCE, shall, upon summary conviction thereof, pay a fine of not more than Twenty five (\$25.00) dollars, and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days.
