## ORDINANCE No.39

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12 OF ORDINANCE NO.21, DATED 4 APRIL 1964, KNOWN AS THE "WAGE TAX ORDINANCE" BY PROVIDING INCREASED JURISDICTION OVER ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS, AND BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO NUMBERED 13, AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF WAGE ATTACHMENTS FOR DELINQUENT TAXES.

THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON HEREBY ORDAINS AND ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Section 12 of Ordinance No.21, dated 4 April 1964known as the "Wage Tax Ordinance" be amended to read as follows:
- "Any person convicted before a Justice of the Peace or Alderman of Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, of violating any of the provisions or requirements of this Ordinance, etc."..
- 2. That a new section numbered 13 be added to said "WAGE TAX ORDINANCE" as aforesaid, as follows:
- "13- That wage attachments be issued by the Township Tax Collector for delinquent taxes, and the said Township Tax Collectorshall include his costs in said attachments.".
