- 2. The following taxes have been re-enacted for the year 1975 without substantial change:
 - (a) One (1%) per cent real estate transfer tax.
 - (b) Ten(\$10,00) Dollar occupational privilege tax.
 - (c) Ten(\$10.00) Dollar flat rate occupation tax.
