The Township of South Huntingdon hereby ordains the following:

A tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the Township of South Huntingdon, subject to taxation for Township purposes for the year 1976.

- 1. Tax rate for general Township purposes, the sum of 10 mills on each dollar of Assessed Valuation.
- 2. The following taxes have been re-enacted for the year 1975 without substantial change:
  - (a) One (1%) per cent real estate transfer tax.
  - (b) Ten (\$10.00) Dollar occupational privilege tax.
  - (c) Ten (\$10.00) Dollar flat rate occupation tax.

TOTAL MILLAGE: 10 mills.
