- 2. The following taxes have been re-enacted for the year 1977 without substantial change:
- (a). One (1%) per cent real estate transfer tax.
- (b). Ten (\$10.00) Dollar occupational privilege tax.
- (c). Ten (\$10.00) Dollar flat rate occupational tax.
