AN ORDIANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC ROAD KNOWN AS MARGINAL ROAD "H" SITUATE IN SOUTH HUNTINGDON TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PA:

WHEREAS, the Township of South Huntingdon, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania (the Township) under the Authority granted to it by the Second Class Township Code Act of May 1, 1933 P.L. 103 Article XI, 1101 et. seq. as amended and supplemented; 53 P.S. 66101 et seq, is empowered inter alia, to vacate by Ordianche roads and parts therof which are within the Township upon petition of interested citizens;

AND WHEREAS, all of the owners of property adjoining land adjacent to the portion of the road which is herein to be vacated have petitioned the Township for said vacation;

AND WHEREAS said property owners have released and discharged the Township from any and all damages which may arise by reason of the vacation of siad portion of a public road;

AND WHEREAS it is the opinion of the Supervisors of the Township that the vacation of said portion of a public road is in the best interest of the citizens, residents, and tax payers of the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF SOUTH HUNTIN DON TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, and it is hereby ORDAINED and ENACTED by the authority of the same:

SECTION I: A portion of marginal road "H" containing 0.2492 acres, as more particularly described in Exhibits A and B attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby vacated.

SECTION II: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall become law effective five (5) days after the date of its final passage as provided by law.
