AN ORDINANCE OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO CHANGE THE BENEFITS IT HAS IN THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER ARTICLE IV OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW: AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW AS AMENDED AND AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES CHANGING BENEFITS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE: STATING WHICH OF CERTAINS OPTIONS PERMITTED UNDER SAID LAW ARE ACCEPTED BY THE TOWNSHIP. IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY SOUTH HUNTINGDON TOWNSHIP, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. South Huntingdon Township, being a member municipality of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, hereby elects to change its member benefits in that System as authorized by the Pennsylvania Retirement Law, as amended, and does hereby agree to be bound by all the requirements and provisions of said Article and the Law, as the case may be. All references hereafter shall be based on benefits negotiated between the Baord and the municipality under the provisions of Article IV.

SECTION II. Membership in the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System shall be mandatory for all permanent, municipal employees of the Township. Memebership for elected officials and employees hired on a temporary or seasonal basis is prohibited, as is membership for individuals paid on a fee basis.

SECTION III. Credit for prior service for original members is granted for each year or partial year thereof that the member was employed by the Township from original date of hire or the expiration of the member's probationary period if one so existed. Benefits provided to members in the agreement dated February 8, 1996, shall accrue based on all credited service granted and earned in accordance with this section.

SECTION IV. Payment for any obligation established by the adoption of this ordinance and the agreement between the System and South Huntingdon Township shall be made by the Township in accordance with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law and Act 205 of 1984, the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act.

SECTION V. As part of this ordinance, the Township agrees that the System shall provide the benefits set forth in the agreement between the Board and South Huntingdon Township, dated February 8, 1996. The passage and adoption of this ordinance by South Huntingdon Township is an official acceptance of said agreement and the financial obligations resulting from the administration of said benefit package. South Huntingdon Township hereby assumes all liability for any unfundness created or which may be created due to the acceptance of the benefit structure outlines in the above-referenced agreement.

SECTION VI. South Huntingdon Township intends this ordinance to be the complete authorization of the Township plan and it shall repeal the Resolution dated June 23, 1983.

SECTION VII. A duly certified copy of this ordinance and the referenced agreement shall be filed with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Membership for the municipal employees of South Huntingdon Township in the Pennsylvania Retirement System shall be effective the first day of July, 1983, with the revised plan structure reflected in the agreement dated February 8, 1996, effective the first day of January, 1996.
